

1. Present complaint has been filed by the complainant alleging that complainant's application for new connection has been rejected on the pretext of "Fire Safety Clearance Required". Complainant, pleading that respondent has not released new electricity connection with the reason "Fire Safety Clearance Required and dues exists, but complainant alleged that the said reason is absolutely wrong and no dues are pending against the premises. Therefore he prayed this Forum for grant of his complaint by issuing directions to the respondent to allow

his application for new connection.

2. The complainant in his complaint submitted that he applied for new electricity connection at premises no. 7531/1, Third Floor, Tel Mill Street Ram Nagar, Paharganj, Delhi-55 vide Request no. 8006061269 but respondent rejected his application for new connection on the pretext of Fire Safety Clearance Required (G+4 commercial) and dues exists, but no dues are pending against the premises. Therefore, complainant's application for release of new connection may be granted.
3. OP in its reply briefly submitted that the complainant applied for fresh electricity connection at premises no. 7531/1, Third Floor, Tel Mill Street Ram Nagar, Paharganj, Delhi-55 vide Request no. 8006061269 and same was rejected an account of building height more than 15 meters and MCD Objection both of relocation, ceiling and that of unauthorized construction.
4. Case was put up for hearing on 05.04.2023, when representative of the complainant was present and submitted withdrawal letter stating therein that he wishes to withdraw his complaint.
5. In the facts and circumstances the withdrawal is allowed. Hence, the complaint is dismissed as withdrawn.
6. No order as to the cost. Both the parties should be informed accordingly. File be consigned to Record Room.
