- 1) This review application has been filed by the applicant under Regulation 19 of Delhi Electricity Regulatory Commission (Forum for redressal of Grievances of the Consumers and Ombudsman) Regulations, 2018.

2) By way of this review application, the applicant has sought to review the order dated 23.01.2024 passed by this forum in CG no. 370/23. As per the applicant by way of the present order OP was directed to release the new connection in favor of complainant. It is stated in the application that the order, of release of the connection, was subject to the condition of filling of affidavit by the complainant affirming the undertaking to the effect that he shall maintain the safety majors, during the supply of the electricity, so as to avoid any accident, duly attested by the concerned SDM. As per OP, the affidavit on record doesn't fulfill the requirement as per order of the PLA as the same is not attested by the SDM and doesn't affirm that the complainant shall maintain the safety majors, during the supply of the electricity, so as to avoid accident. Thus the ground of review as shown in the application is improper affidavit.

3) Regulation 19 of the DERC regulation 2018 provides two ground only for filling application to review an order (i) Discovery of new and important matter or evidence which after the exercise of due diligence was not within his knowledge or could not be produced by the applicant at the time of passing of the order, and (ii) Mistake or error apparent on the face of the record. We find none of the two conditions available in the present review application. Hence the review application being not maintainable is hereby dismissed.


