1. Present complaint has been filed by the complainant alleging that complainant's application for new connection has been rejected on the pretext of premises under MCD objection list. Complainant, pleading that respondent has wrongly concluded that his premises is booked by

MCD, has prayed this Forum for grant of his complaint by issuing directions to the respondent to allow his application for new connection.

Complaint No. 125/2023

2. The complainant in his complaint submitted that he applied for new electricity connection at premises no. 483-C, Plot No. 15, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, GT Road, Bargees Park, Dilshad Garden, Dlehi-110095 vide application no. 8006087602 and 8006087593 but respondent rejected his application for new connections on the pretext of premises appearing in MCD objection list and enforcement dues against same premises. Therefore, complainant's application for release of new connection may be granted.
3. Case was put up for hearing on 23.03.2023, when counsel of the complainant submitted that both the parties have settled the dispute amicably outside the court and now complainant wants to withdraw the present complaint.
4. In the facts and circumstances the withdrawal is allowed. Hence, the complaint is dismissed as withdrawn.
5. No order as to the cost. Both the parties should be informed accordingly.
