


1. Present complaint has been filed by the complainant alleging that complainant's application for new connection has been rejected on the pretext of premises booked by MCD. Complainant, pleading that respondent has wrongly concluded that his premises are ~~not~~ booked by MCD, has prayed this Forum for grant of his complaint by issuing directions to the respondent to allow his applications for new connection.

Complaint No. 23/2023

2. The complainant in his complaint submitted that he applied for new electricity connection at premises no. 1/4649/B-15, out of Khasra No. 175/874/174, village Chandrawali, Gali No. 11, New Modern Shahdara, Delhi-110032 vide application no. 8005812640, 8005812649 and 8005812659 but respondent rejected his application for new connections on the pretext of premises appearing in MCD objection list. Therefore, complainant's application for release of new connection may be granted.
3. Case was put up for hearing on 02.02.2023, when counsel of the complainant submitted withdrawal letter stating therein that as per requirement of OP they got prepared BCC and now OP has released her new connections. Therefore, she wishes to withdraw her case.
4. Under the circumstances, the Forum found it appropriate to accept and allow the complainant's withdrawal application and dispose off the case accordingly.
5. No order as to the cost. Both the parties should be informed accordingly.
