Present review under Regulation 19 of DERC (Forum for Redressal of Grievances of the Consumers and Ombudsman) REGULATIONS, 2018 has been filed by the complainant against order passed by this Forum, in CG no. 04/2025 dated 14.05.2025. Ground for review the complainant states that there is an error apparent on the face of the record. As per the review application "....



Point 3 of review application:-

As per law and legal practices CGRF did not take up an higher courts (High Court of Gujarat at Ahmadabad), High Court of Punjab & Haryana at Chandigarh and DERC Supply Code 2017 Regulations, legally and seriously wherein point no. 7 of out closing statement specifically states that where an applicant is in possession of the property Discom cannot deny an electricity connection to the occupier.

2. As per para 4 of the review application, the complainant stated that the name change request in the name of Jugal Kishore Mehra as per law and after submission of all documents presented by Jugal Kishore Mehra but nothing was produced before CGRF.
3. It is clearly evident that the Forum passed its order on the basis of complainant's incompetency in proving his occupation/possession of the property in question which is as per DERC Regulations 2017.
4. Thus there is no mistake or error apparent on the face of record. Hence the review, being devoid of merit as per Regulation concerned, is not maintainable and is accordingly, dismissed.
