1. The brief facts of the case giving rise to this grievance are that the complainants applied for new electricity connections at premises no. 97-A, GF, FF, SF, TF, vide requests no. 8006974664, 8006977595, 8006974642, 8006977584, 8006974690 and 8006977604. The applications of complainants were rejected by OP on the pretext of dues at site, dues of regular meter 70150849.

2. The respondent in reply briefly stated that the present complaint has been filed by three complainants namely, Sanjay Kumar Aggarwal, Ajay Kumar and Naresh Kumar Aggarwal seeking six new connections on different floors of property bearing no. 97-A, Narain Nagar, Laxmi Nagar, Delhi, three connections at Ground floor, one connection at first floor and two connections at third floor vide application no. 8006974664, 8006977595, 8006974642, 8006977584, 8006974690 and 8006977604.

Reply further stated that the connections as applied for by the complainants were rejected on the grounds of arrears on premises and dues of existing connection. A bill of UUE amounting to Rs. 64,864/- is pending in respect of CA no. 152975875. Regular energy dues amounting to Rs. 3027/- against CA no. 152975875 is still pending and another regular energy bill amounting to Rs. 1,01,820/- against CA no. 152827983 is also pending.

3. In response to the reply of the OP, the complainant in its rejoinder submitted that he has settled and cleared the bill of UUE for an amount of Rs. 10,500/-. Rejoinder further cleared that the complainant has cleared the regular energy dues also.

4. On the final date of hearing, the OP verified the statement of the complainant and submitted that the complainant had cleared all the dues.

5. In view of the above, since the requirement of OP has been fulfilled by the complainant, therefore, OP should now release the new electricity connections to the complainant.

The parties are hereby informed that instant Order is appealable by the Consumer before the Ombudsman within 30 days of the receipt of the Order.

If the Order is not appealed against within the stipulated time, the same shall be deemed to have attained finally.

Any contravention of these Orders is punishable under Section 142 of the Electricity Act 2003.
